

## **How to Designate a Gift Through Your United Way Contribution**

The United Way has a “donor choice policy” which gives donors the option to designate any part of their donation to a registered Canadian charity.

### **How can I designate my United Way gift to International Justice Mission Canada?**

If you choose to donate online to the national office of the United Way, (<https://give.unitedway.ca/donate/UWCCC>) you can make a note of your designation in the notes section of the giving form. Please identify International Justice Mission Canada, a registered Canadian charity with a charitable registration number (**86388 9283 RR0001**), as your desired designee for your gift.

Each local United Way may have slightly different giving procedures. You can find your local United Way [here](#). To ensure your gift is properly designated, please contact your local United Way office to confirm the correct procedure. ### **Is there a processing fee?**

Yes, most United Way locations will administer a processing fee if you choose to designate your gift to International Justice Mission Canada.

### **Will I receive a tax receipt?**

If you contributed via payroll deduction or through a pension plan, your gift should be reflected on your T4 and a tax receipt is not required. If you donated by credit card or cheque, please [contact your local United Way](#) to obtain a receipt.
