### Elementary:

### Upper Elementary:

- Arul and Pachayamma were exhausted when they were working as slaves. What's the most exhausted you have ever been? Why?
- Arul and Pachayamma moved into a new home when they were set free from slavery. What do you like about your home? Would you change anything about it?

### Junior High:

- Pachayamma spoke up and told the authorities to trust their story of slavery and help set them free. Have you ever spoken up to help someone else? Is there someone in your life or your community who needs help?
- Arul and Pachayamma are leaders in their community. Who is a leader in your life? What makes them a good leader?



### RESEARCH PROMPT:
