## AT INTERNATIONAL JUSTICE MISSION. WE KNOW THE WORK OF JUSTICE TAKES TIME.

Helen\* and Emilia\* were just 3 and 6 years old when they were violently abused by their neighbour. Their case was one of the longest battles for justice IJM has ever fought in Bolivia.

Child sexual assault cases in Bolivia often go nowhere, thwarted by court delays and defense stall tactics that exhaust a victim's emotions and finances. The sisters' case was no exception.

At times, things seemed hopeless. The person who abused them had fled and gone into hiding, nowhere to be found. Their court case was delayed so badly that it risked being dismissed by a judge.

"My lawyer said that IJM would forget about the case," the perpetrator told an IJM investigator. "'Run', he said, 'They will forget about the case."

His lawyer was wrong. Because of supporters like you, we persisted in a often forgotten.

We pursued the case for eight years and finally in 2016, justice was served. The abuser was located, arrested, and sentenced to 12 years in prison. Thanks to your enduring support, we were able to stand with Helen and Emilia during the long fight, providing them with initial medical attention and ongoing therapy.
